

Persephone Theatre Young Company FAQs

What is the Persephone Theatre Young Company?

The Persephone Theatre Young Company is both **a class** and **a theatre company** for young performers between the ages of 14 and 19 years who are interested in pursuing a career in the arts. The Young Company students have the opportunity to thrive in a classroom setting while also getting to study with professional theatre artists. *For the 2024 /25 Season, we will be moving to a different model in which all students <u>must be</u> enrolled in Term 1 in order to take Term 2.*

<u>Term 1: Sept 9 – Dec 12</u>

Tuition \$750+TAX*

<u>Classes:</u> Mondays** from 6:30-9PM, plus select Saturdays from 1-5:30PM*** in Nov/Dec and dress rehearsals before presentation on Dec 12th.

<u>The focus</u>: will be on *skill building* (vocal, physical, creating character, monologue and scene work, etc.) as well as *script work* for our production in March. Script work will include in depth discussions from scene-to-scene, etc. and is beneficial for all students, even if they will not continuing onto Term 2. There will be an evening presentation of monologues and scenes on December 12 for family.

<u>Term 2: Jan 6 – March 23</u>

Tuition \$750+TAX*

<u>Classes will be on</u> Mondays^{**} from 6:30-9PM & every second Saturday from 1-5:30PM. Plus additional classes in March^{***}.

The focus will be on a *traditional theatre rehearsal* (character building, blocking, scene work, learning any needed choreography, etc.) and culminating in a *full-scale theatre production* (including lights, sound, costumes, set, etc.) in Persephone Theatre's Backstage from March 20-23. Students must be in Term 1 to partake in Term 2.

* <u>To secure student spot</u>- a non-refundable deposit of \$100 must be paid by June 26, 2024 ** <u>Monday night classes are mandatory</u> throughout both terms- <u>no exceptions</u> (other then statutory holidays, in emergencies, or due to illness) *** Additional Classes- a schedule will be provided at the auditions

Both Terms will have:

• A couple of **Guest Speakers** - professional theatre artists from different areas of theatre (from stage management, design, acting, to directing).

• **Theatre Critique** opportunities - students will watch 2 shows* from Persephone's season followed by an in depth discussions about the experience, themes, production approaches, etc. **The cost of tickets are included in Tuition fee.*

NOTE: As Young Company is intended for a more mature age group and as the students are interested in pursuing a career in theatre, topics will be explored that are current in our world today (and throughout history). This may include LGBTQ+ rights, war, homelessness, etc. Persephone will provide a safe, inclusive, and healthy atmosphere to explore these issues in an age appropriate manner.

Do you need to have attended past Persephone School classes or have acting experience to apply?

The only pre-requisite is a strong passion for sharing a story and expressing oneself through theatrical performance.

How much of a time commitment is the Young Company?

Young Company is a big commitment. Each term has over twenty classes/rehearsals. NOTE: A schedule will be provided at audition.

How do you get to be a part of Young Company? How do I apply/audition?

Students must fill out an **application form** and then **audition**.

The application form consists of the regular information requests (name, age, address) along with a section where applicants provide information about themselves and their theatre interests. Do not worry, it is not a test. We just want to get to know you! If you are selected, Kristi Friday will contact you for an interview/audition.

The audition is very laid-back and open. There will be an individual and group audition. The *Individual audition* is where students get to share their abilities and will include a few minutes with parent/guardian to go over the commitment and expectations involved. Auditioners will be asked to: Choose a monologue provided by Kristi. The *Group auditions* are to see how individuals work with others.

Note: Depending on application numbers, not all applicants may be asked to come and audition.

What if I only want to work behind the scenes? Do I still have to audition?

That's great! In this case: You will be asked to

1. Prepare one of the audition pieces provided by Persephone.

2. Prepare a brief presentation on what it is you would like to focus on and why (stage management or directing).

3. Play a few quick, basic improv games in small groups.
