# PRESIDENT'S Message to the Community

During the past year, we welcomed many new board members: Rick Fedorchuk, Tessa Dyer, Nikesh Madhar, Margot Orr-Stevenson, Sara Wurst and Caitrin Hodson. They have all been wonderful additions to the board and have jumped in enthusiastically as active members on committees and at the board table. Rick assumed the role of Facilities Chair at the start of this year and has been an outstanding support to Breanne, Heather and the Production department, as the building has undergone some major upgrades in the past few years, including replacing a portion of the roof and a major renovation to the lobby and bathrooms. Caitrin also recently assumed the role of chair of the newly formed External Relations committee. The committee's mandate is to advocate and engage with government, donors and sponsors on behalf

of Persephone. The committee is well underway in supporting theatre tours for MPs, MLAs and City Councillors.

This year, we say goodbye to Sara Wurst and Ryan Moccasin as board members. However, Ryan is not going too far and we are thrilled he is interested in supporting Persephone through committee work. Both Sara and Ryan have been steady supports to the theatre since joining the board, and we congratulate both of them as they continue to strengthen their own work.

At Persephone, our ongoing dedication to fostering a space which embraces diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility continues to guide us. During the past year, we have witnessed how our recent lobby renovations have impacted the flow of patrons and increased accessibility in the theatre. You may have noticed shorter lines at both the bathrooms and the concession. A big thank you to Ellen Remai and the Frank and Ellen Remai Foundation, who made the renovation possible. We also are planning more accessibility upgrades to the lobby in the near future to increase mobility and flow of traffic. Our commitment to accessibility programming continues with Pay-What-You-Choose tickets, Relaxed Performances, ASL interpreted performances, and PlayDate, where a youth Theatre School program is offered simultaneously during a matinee performance of our Main Stage productions.

Heather and Breanne continue to devote themselves wholeheartedly to bringing vibrant productions and meaningful programs to our stages and spaces – works that inspire, provoke thought, and nourish the soul. Their leadership remains grounded in empathy and warmth, and their unwavering commitment to the theatre is truly remarkable. I'm deeply grateful for their strong guidance and the collaborative spirit they share with each other and the board. The theatre has had a number of new staff members join us in the 2024-25 season. This season, we welcomed new Scenic Artist Ankita Sharma and Development Officer Ericka Bold to the Persephone team, and bid a fond farewell to Artistic Associate – Community Building Grahame Kent, Development Officer Jory McKay, and Production Assistant Rory Jewiss.

# SENIOR LEADERSHIP Report to the Community

Persephone celebrated its 50th milestone season this year, and to say it was an exciting season is a true understatement. This season we celebrated the people, the places and the moments that have brought Persephone to this special milestone, kicking the season off with our 50th Anniversary Red Rose Gala on August 14, 2024 — our birthday — at The Glen at Crossmount. We were joined by honorary guests, including Founding Artistic Director Brian Richmond, and Rosalie Woloski, the wife of the late Tibor Feheregyhazi, with entertainment provided by local artists Tim Bratton and Amanda Trapp and Deb Buck as MC. The event was a beautiful celebration, and the perfect way to mark 50 years.

We spent this season reflecting on seasons past and the many people who made this significant anniversary season possible. Each week throughout the season, we were proud to publicly share interviews, photos, and history about some of the many individuals and events integral to Persephone's founding, growth, artistry, and community impact since its beginnings, as a celebration of their contributions – our success is their success!

This season, we welcomed new Scenic Artist Ankita Sharma and Development Officer Ericka Bold to the Persephone team, and bid a fond farewell to Artistic Associate — Community Building Grahame Kent, and Development Officer Jory McKay, as well as Production Assistant Rory Jewiss, as he embarks on his Masters of Arts at the University of Alberta this fall.

The 2024/25 season consisted of six shows on the Main Stage, engaging artists with storied histories with Persephone, as well as those working with us for the first time: We opened the season with ***Native Gardens* by Karen Zachariás**, followed by a presentation of Edmonton's award-winning Catalyst Theatre with ***The Invisible: Agents***





of *Ungentlemanly Warfare*, book and lyrics by Jonathan Christenson; the holidays offered the beloved family classic *Miracle on 34th Street*, adapted by Caleb Marshall and Erin Keating from the classic story by Valentine Davies, playing to large crowds with an extended run; the new year brought the World Premiere of the prairie comedy *18 Jews Order Chinese Food* by local playwright Jenna “JB” Berenbaum, in partnership with the Saskatchewan Jewish Arts Festival; followed by the one man masterpiece *Made in Italy* by Farren Timoteo; and closing the season, the rock n’ roll showstopper *Million Dollar Quartet*, book by Colin Escott and Floyd Mutrux, rocked the Theatre selling out the run! As an incredible bonus, we hosted comedy legend Brent Butt for a one-night-only, sold-out fundraising event. Brent’s connections to

Persephone and his Saskatchewan roots made for an unforgettable evening.

We had three Youth Series shows initially scheduled; unfortunately due to circumstances outside of their control, Green Thumb Theatre had to cancel the fall presentation and school tour of *The Mixolydian* by Ashley Cook. The Youth Series had two successful productions, the World Premiere of *The Adventure of Young Turtle* by S.E. Grummett, brought to us from Saskatoon’s own So.Glad Arts; and a beautiful production from Voyageurs Immobiliers, *G’Zaagiiin Maleñki – I Promise You a Forest*, for our youngest audiences yet — 18 months to five years, presented in partnership with the Remai Modern, and melded performance art with a visual art activity.

We continued our successful partnership with SUM Theatre to present the third edition of *The First Monday*, a monthly, free, staged play-reading series supporting Saskatchewan playwrights in their development of new work. Persephone also produced the *4th Annual 48-Hour Queermunity Theatre Race* in support of Pride, with all funds raised going to Pride Home, a local charity that supports at-risk queer youth. We also entered into a successful round of collective bargaining negotiations with IATSE Local 300 for a new three-year agreement.

Since 2023, we have been in partnership with the City of Saskatoon Public Art, Graffiti Prevention, Indigenous Inclusion, and Immigration, Diversity & Inclusion Departments, working towards companion public and performance art pieces, with a focus on the Indigenous, Newcomer and Immigrant experience in Saskatoon. What started out as a conversation about a public mural aimed at graffiti prevention, grew into an almost two-year partnership which coupled a gorgeous community mural at Cosmos Skate Park, and the creation of a community-centered verbatim-style piece of theatre, *Welcome to My Country* by Lauturo Reyes, with artistic contributions from Manuela Valle Castro, Art Babayants, and members of the Saskatoon community. Its first public viewing took place at the end of the season, to enthusiastic audience feedback. With Lauturo’s leadership, the community members will continue to develop this project, and we cannot wait to watch its continued growth. The companion piece for the play was a large mural at Cosmos Skate Park, created in collaboration with local Indigenous Elders and youth from White Buffalo Youth Lodge, and painted by 30 youth from three schools: WP Bate, Aden Bowman and Tommy Douglas.



We entered into a second two-week development workshop for the inaugural IBPoC New Play Commission, Rachel Mutombo’s newest play *Wake*, and continued development on the second play commissioned under this program, Frances Koncan’s *Medea’s Masquerade*.

In addition to the offerings on stage and in new play development, we continued to grow our youth programming activities. Persephone’s Theatre School programming has continued to see incredible growth, greatly surpassing previous


years' enrollment and participation, and we had the pleasure of offering a wide variety of programming for youth ages 2-19; including a full year musical theatre academy program, culminating in a performance of *Disney's Descendants*, as well as the 2024 summer musical *Spongebob Squarepants: The Musical* on our Main Stage (with more than 50 young people!). Young Company was back in full swing, with the students sharing the full-scale presentation of *Cacophony* by **Molly Taylor**.



We continued to open our doors, both literally and figuratively to the community through numerous community-building initiatives, including: The David Edney Community Library, a free theatre resource library; Pomegranate Gallery, with curated exhibits to complement the shows on our stages; IBPoC New Play Commission, with development workshops; The RBC Artist Mentorship Program (AMP), with paid mentorship opportunities for Saskatchewan artists to work with discipline-specific mentors on a Persephone production or within a Persephone department; as well as a staunch commitment to community arts support, offering community rental rates, resources, and in-kind support to numerous artists and community groups in the city and province, and in this season alone, gifting more than \$50,000 in free or subsidized space and resources. We hosted our second Artistic

Salon, where we invited patrons to join Heather Cant in conversation about Persephone's programming and the future of the organization, as we feel doing this annually allows for more open dialogue, and we look forward to continuing to invest in our patrons and stakeholders. Persephone continues to make strides in our work on equity, diversity, inclusion, and accessibility, and in our investment in the community, which remains a top priority. This season, across our artistic programming, 58% of the artists we engaged were from Saskatoon, 3% of the artists we engaged were from Saskatchewan (outside of Saskatoon), and 39% of the artists we engaged were from elsewhere in Canada, with more than fifty of the artists directly engaged by Persephone being new to the organization.

Our work with a number of multi-year cohorts and ancillary committees/groups continues to strengthen our relationships within the local and national communities, while increasing organizational capacity and immersion in EDIA informed systems, and contributing to the overall theatre ecology in Canada. We continue our work as Co-Coordinator, alongside the Belfry Theatre and University of Regina's Centre for Socially Engaged Theatre (C-SET), with the Arts Leadership Training Program. This national initiative features both seminars with prominent IBPoC arts leaders, and paid internships for IBPoC artists and arts administrators, with the goal of providing our next generation of leaders the opportunity to gain hands on experience and mentorship. The PACT-supported Rising Tides and Connected Currents (formerly Open Door) initiative is continuing to grow, with the program heading into its third cohort, supporting early to mid-career IBPoC arts workers with paid mentorship exchange aimed at career growth. This spring, Executive Director Breanne Harmon was also elected to the Professional Association of Canadian Theatres (PACT) Board of Directors, as the Advocacy Co-Chair, which, paired with the new External Relations Committee on the board, will continue to enhance our government advocacy efforts municipally, provincially and federally.



This season, we also launched our **Raising the Roof Capital Campaign** to raise \$2 million to replace the roof. With an incredibly generous donation of \$300,000 over three-years (2023, 2024 and 2025) from Malcolm and Marilyn Leggett, we were able to fulfill the replacement of the most damaged part of the roof — the fly tower, directly above the Rawlco Radio Hall Main Stage. Along with the Leggetts' gift, the campaign has been supported by the City of Saskatoon Cultural Capital Grant Program, along with a strong support from our patrons and local

community through individual donations. We are currently in the process of securing the remaining funds to enact the final two phases of the roof replacement project.



In addition to the completion of the first phase of the roof replacement, we received a tremendous gift of \$500,000 from Ellen Remai from the Frank and Ellen Remai Foundation to increase accessibility through some much-needed front-end renovations! With a brand new fully accessible bar and concession, new custom built All Gendered Bathrooms, and new paint in both the lobby and Main Stage Theatre, the space is modern, welcoming, and enhances access both for patrons and workers.

While the live performing arts sector continues to face immense challenges, we were incredibly fortunate this season to have such strong community support. With an increase in attendance on the Main Stage of 27% from the previous year, we saw an average attendance of

83% across our programming, including countless full houses throughout the season, which included a hold-over week for *Miracle on 34th Street* and a sold out run of our season closer *Million Dollar Quartet*! Because of the strong community support, robust audience attendance, exciting fundraising events – like the gala and Brent Butt show – and unplanned funding from Prairies Economic Development (PrairiesCan) to support our Accessibility and Audience Engagement Programs, we are ending the year in a much needed surplus position. We recognize the years coming out of lock down have posed significant challenges, putting our sector at risk, and we are elated our strategic decisions have led us to end the 50th season in a healthy financial position, allowing us to begin the process of deficit paydown. We will continue our efforts in advocating for increased economic support, while reimagining and strategically finetuning our business model to support sustained growth.

The excitement of this anniversary season has both invigorated and inspired us, and we are grateful to our staff, artists, volunteers and patrons who keep this place going — they are what has brought us to this incredible milestone of 50 years. A huge thank you to our staff, artists, and volunteers past and present for the incredible work, passion, and skill you bring to work everyday, and to our patrons for choosing to make Persephone your home.

We also want to acknowledge the incredible contributions from our Board of Directors, and want to thank each and every one of them for their dedication, innovation and passion for Persephone. This season, we say goodbye to Board Members Sara Wurst and Ryan Moccasin. We want to thank Sara and Ryan for their contributions to the Persephone board. We are delighted Ryan will continue on as a committee member this coming season! We also want to thank our Board Chair Terice Coleman for her years of service to the board, and for her guidance and support. While Terice will be stepping into the Past President role on the board, we are thrilled she will continue to serve the board, and are grateful for her leadership these past three years.

One chapter has closed, and a new one has opened — to 50 more years!


